Use the CIA Award Form to log /record all activities. Record the category under the appropriate heading. Use as many forms as needed. Print another form when you need extra space. This program uses the honor system; minors need a parents/guardians signature.

The Curlies in Action award program has a *NEW Category*! **Training (general)**, **ring/arena/round pen work as well as ground driving.** We all know how important it is to present our Curlies as trained using horses to the public. Now you can get rewarded for all your hard work and get the recognition you need as an active participant in training your Curlies. Whether it is training a foal to lead and load in a trailer to working in the ring/arena or round pen or beginning riding or ground driving, you earn points for your training work. This includes honing skills of older horses too that need ring work or learning new things. Please take part in this fun new category and the let the Curly world see what you are doing with your Curlies.

We also have categories for **Trail riding**, **Cart/ Wagon Driving**, **Competitive Trail and Endurance**, **Ranch/Farm work**, **Events that includes** Parades, Clinics, Demos and Horse Fairs too! Join the fun and get your Curlies into the Action. Click on forms to print one easy to use form. Use one form for each horse, \$5.00 per horse. Use as many forms as you need for as many ICHO registered Curly horses as you have.

REQUIREMENTS:

- Horses must be ICHO/NACHR registered to qualify for CIA awards program.
- Rider, driver, trainer or participant must be a member of ICHO in good standing.
- Points/miles are accumulated from Jan 1 thru Dec 31. Logs must be postmarked no later than Jan. 15. Make and keep a copy for your records.
- Annual \$5.00 fee per Curly

ICHO Curlies in Action Award Program

CATEGORIES:

- EVENTS- Horse Fairs, demos, clinics, Parades 20 points horse and 20 points for owner participation. (includes Equine Affair type Breed gatherings, local fairs, Nursing home visits, riding clinics, 4H clinics/demos, re-enactments like Civil War, Native American Pow Wows, Ranch/farm Open houses for Curlies, Mitch's Comanche Riding, Hosting an ICHO AGM, Hosting an Inspection Clinic, also <u>attending a show with your Curly but did not</u> qualify for ICHO show awards & placed lower than 1st place, etc)
- Trail Rides & Cart or Wagon Driving, Organized or home. 5 Points per hour plus mileage of ride or cart/wagon drive.
- **Competitive or Endurance Riding**, 5 Points per hour plus mileage.
- Working Ranch/Farm 5 points per hour. (General work using your Curly)
- Training 5 points per hour. Includes general training, teaching to lead, load, tricks, etc. Ring/arena and round pen work, ground driving.

AWARDS:

All participants will receive yearly Certificate Awards with points/mileage documented. First and Second Place receive Ribbons also.

Yearly High Point/Mileage/Participant Awarded for the above individual categories as well as Overall High Point/ Mileage/Participant Award of all combined categories accumulated from past years (must participate to be recognized) Points/mileage accumulates from year to year (Jan 1 – Dec 31) Forms Due by Jan 15.

LEVELS:

BRONZE ~10-100 points &/or mileage SILVER ~ 101-500 points &/or mileage GOLD ~ 501-1000 points &/or mileage PLATINUM ~ 1001 and over for points &/or mileage
